Excelsior College exams are offered worldwide at Pearson VUE Professional Centers. Excelsior College exams remain a very cost effective means of earning lower and upper-division college credit, especially for relocated students. Students may use Excelsior credits to fulfill the requirements for General Education, Common Body of Knowledge, Core, and major courses in their undergraduate degree programs at WIU, based on the scores below. Lower-division credits in excess of 72 are not applied toward bachelor degree programs. Lower-division credits are not applied to WIU major courses. WIU reserves the right to change what will be accepted in transfer at any time.
